CATCH IT

Install a drain sump below each of your downspouts to catch rain water. Water should flow freely into grate so that leaves, debris, or ice jams can easily exit downspout preventing gutter backups.

CLEAN IT

Rain water and smaller roof debris pass through the sump drain's grate.

Debris settles to the bottom of the sump while storm water exits through the drain pipe. This helps keep drain pipes clean for years of service.

MOVE IT

Water exits the sump through connected pipe and discharges where you want it, far from your home's foundation.





Downspout discharge floods foundations & landscapes. Splash blocks & extensions do not move water far enough from the foundation and are unsightly.




DRAIN SUMP FEATURES

- Sump buried below grade virtually "disappears" into landscape.
- Grate easily removed for debris clean-out.
- High capacity sump chamber.
- UV resistant, polymer drain sump box construction for a lifetime of trouble-free service.

Heavy load, UV resistant grate keeps larger debris from entering sump.

- 4 ½" clearance between top of drain pipe and top of sump allows for encapsulation in concrete or other hardscape applications.
- 6" deep sump base catches & holds debris, keeping drain lines cleaner.
- Optional "weep holes" can be drilled into sump bottom to eliminate standing water.
- Multiple Tuf-Tite Drain Sumps can be linked to connect to common drain pipe.
